UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

On 12th June, 1961, an unidentified flying object was sighted by two residents of the Northern District. The District Commissioner of that District has reported as follows:-

"The object was seen by Mr. and Mrs. Of Azerita Plantation at 4 a.m. and for a period of about 15 minutes. They say that the shining object approached the North East and was shaped like the nollow in a new moon, and could have been delta winged. The object was at an estimated height of 15,000 feet and kept moving backwards and forwards to and from the North East.

On one particular occasion it moved to the North East until it became the size of a pin's head then returned. Eventually it returned the way it came. No noise was heard and only the bright object was seen.

Mr. and Mrs. have travelled widely and he was employed by United Nations Organisation for some time. They may be considered as being reliable."
